### **Home Learning**

For those pupils remaining at home as a result of the rota system, we will continue to post out, add to TEAMs or email school work home. This work will reflect what would have been taught within school, work that is completed should be returned to school via the taxi or via email to the subject teacher.

### Free School Meal Vouchers

For those pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals, you will receive **one voucher** equivalent to two school days meals, for the time your child will be working from home, due to the continuation of the rota system.
