Dear Parents/ Carers,

As the exam season is quickly approaching, I wanted to write to you to inform you of certain points that you need to be aware of regarding the GCSE exam period.

GCSE Examinations Summer 2024

The GCSE exam series will run from Tuesday 7th May through till Friday 14th June. This excludes GCSE contingency days, which I have included in a separate letter, giving you further guidance.

Dates and times

All GCSE exams are scheduled to start at either 9.30am or 1.15pm, depending upon the date and time of the exam, which I have attached a calendar to help pupils and parents to plan and revise.

Preparing for exams

The exam season can be a difficult and stressful time for pupils, which they can feel under pressure. You can really support your son/ daughter by ensuring they eat well and at regular intervals and get some early nights, ensuring they are rested and prepared for their exams. Although difficult, encourage pupils to revise in advance of their exams. Their subject teachers should be able to guide pupils in revision materials.

If you need any additional support leading up to your exams, please speak with your subject teacher, who will be only too happy to help with revision or

Equipment

All equipment will be supplied by school for each exam. This will take the pressure of the pupils in case they lose any equipment or forget something. If a pupil would like to use their own equipment, this will need to be brought in a clear pencil case or clear bag. All personal equipment will be checked by an invigilator prior to the start of the exam.


Water is allowed to be brought into the examination room but must in a clear screw top water bottle without any plastic label.

Please note that mobile phones and any other electronic devices not provided by school, including watches, are not allowed in the examination room. Failure for a candidate to surrender these items prior to an examination could result in disqualification.

At the start of all examinations, pupils will leave their bags at the front of the room, where they will remain to the end of the exam.

EXAM ATTENDANCE AND ILLNESS

Punctuality is vital on the day of the exams. Exams are scheduled to start no later than 9.30am and 1.15pm. As many of our pupils rely on transport, we do not envisage any problems, however if it becomes obvious on the morning of an exam that your child may be late, please contact the school as soon as possible. In the event of unforeseen illness, school needs to know as soon as possible so we can advise on the best approach. It is vitally important that every effort is made to take an exam, pupils who miss a component without supporting medical evidence will not get an exam result.

Study Leave

This year study leave will start on the 10^{th of} May 2024.

For any year 11 pupil wishing to undertake study leave for this exam period, you must notify the head in writing with a parental signature. A slip has been attached at the bottom of this letter and must be returned to the head teacher by **Friday 26th April.**

For anyone not wishing to take part in study leave, provision will be made in school to use the time to revise for exams or to complete any outstanding work missed through the year.

Results will be available for collection between 9.30am and 10.30am on the 22nd August from the School office.

Results will not be handed to friends or parents/carers unless previous arrangements have been made with Miss Turner (Head teacher) or Mr Buckle (Exams Officer) in writing, this must have been done prior to the end of the summer term on Friday 21st July 2023.

Re: Contingency Day for GCSE Examinations 2024 Series

This information is regarding GCSE examinations being taken by your child during the 2024 summer series.

The qualification regulators, JCQ and government departments responsible for education have prepared and agreed information for schools in the event of examinations being seriously disrupted. This jointly agreed information will ensure consistency of response in the event of major disruption to the examinations system affecting significant numbers of candidates.

For the June 2024 exams, the awarding bodies have introduced two additional half-day contingency sessions during the session and a full day after the series has ended. These are on the afternoons of **Thursday 6th June 2024** and **Thursday 13th June 2024**. The standard contingency day remains at the end of the timetable being scheduled on **Wednesday 26th June 2024**.

Therefore, please consider these contingency afternoons and day when making plans for the summer. **Candidates should remain available until Wednesday 26th June 2024 should examinations need to be rescheduled.** Should we experience no disruption during the time tabled exam period, availability on this day will not be required.
