



Home-School Agreement

On admission to the school, parents/carers and the pupil are asked to sign a Home/School agreement. This document is not intended to create any legally binding obligations but does signify an intent by all to work towards the agreed school policies on behaviour, attitude and attendance.

Expectations of Pupils

- To work to the best of their abilities and to allow others to do the same.
- To be polite and considerate to both adults, peers and others they may meet.
- To behave in a non-violent manner.
- To show respect for the property of others.
- To show respect for the fabric of the buildings.
- To ensure they are punctual at the lesson times.
- To attend school regularly.
- To be aware of the needs of others.
- To be aware of the consequences of their behaviour.

Expectations of Staff

Pupils can expect staff to acknowledge behaviour in a variety of ways - a smile, a positive comment, appropriate rewards and recognitions as well as verbal feedback throughout their school day.

Staff will record the positive as well as the negative or inappropriate behaviour on Woodlands monitoring systems (CPOMs and BromCom).

Staff will try wherever possible to ensure that pupils experience success and allow them to take responsibility for their own behaviour by:

- Providing choice and opportunities for taking responsibility
- Building trust
- Helping pupils to develop strategies to regulate effectively.
- Encourage pupils to express their feelings and build positive working relationships with staff.
